Obituary.

Mr. John S. Wilson, who died on Friday morning, March 24th, near Princess Anne, was well known in Somerset and Worcester counties. For nearly thirty years he had been engaged in teaching, either as private tutor or in the public schools, and as such his success was great; his manners and abilities fitting him peculiarly as an instructor of youth.

He was a man of most excellent manners, very amiable disposition and good mind. His heart was kind and tender, and he was as gentle as a woman.

His many friends will be glad to know that the latter part of his life was cheered by the consolations of religion, which he had embraced and rejoiced in for many months before. His sufferings, though protracted, were not painfully severe, and "longing to depart and be with Christ," he passed away without a pain or a struggle.

His remains were carefully interred in the Presbyterian Church yard at Princess Anne under the loving attention of his brother-in-law, S. C. Long, Esq., of Baltimore, followed thither by many sympathizing friends. The funeral services were conducted by the very worthy pastor at Princess Anne, the Rev. A. C. Heaton.

Mr. Wilson was the eldest son of the late E. H. C. and Sarah S. Wilson, formerly of Clifton, Somerset county, Md., was born at Westover in said county, the paternal estate of his family, and belonged to one of the oldest and most honored families of lower Maryland, the same being represented in Worcester in the person of the Hon. E. K. Wilson, a near relative.


