DEATHS.

On the 28th of February 1858, in Washington City, died Henry Augustine Washington much lamented. He confessed his faith in Christ, and put all his trust in Him for his service, saying "my hope is in Christ."

Sarah Augustine Washington, second child of Henry A. & Cynthia B. T. Washington died in Gloucester County Va. October 1st 1862. Thus the race of H. A. Washington became extinct. She remains await the glorious Reunion with those of her infant sister Lucy, in the Church yard of Brenton Parish Church in Williamsburg. "Their ^{angels} faces do always see the face of their Father which is in Heaven." "Thy will be done Oh Lord." "Bereaved of my children I am bereaved!"

DEATHS.

Died at the hour when night & morning meet, September 27th 1883, Catharine Brooke second daughter and youngest child of Charles W. & Cynthia B. T. Coleman in Williamsburg Virginia. Though but a little child she had hope in Christ; and was not afraid. She is buried in Brenton Parish Church yard next to the foot of her grand mother Coleman.

After months of great suffering Dr. Charles W. Coleman entered into rest at the Retreat for the Sick in Richmond, Virginia September 15th 1897.
